## **Minor Example Sheet**

### **Document if:**

**You Have Specifically Retought the Specific Behavior 1 Time Prior** (explicitly\* and 1:1 to the student)

- Behavior takes 2 or more minutes away from your instruction
- Other Students in class are not able to continue given task for a 1 minute period or more
- Behavior inhibits the student from being able to participate in the universal classroom setting with necessary or universal modifications (i.e. removed, doesn't complete any in class tasks)

### **Defiance/ Noncompliance**

- Student refuses to do work after 3 attempts of assistance/modification
- Running or dangerous activity in the hallways
- Not following the Safe, Respectful, Responsible Expectations in a designated area

### **Disrespect**

- Shouting, yelling, or snidely talking to a teacher or student
  - "This is stupid..." "You are unfair..." or name calling
- Walking away from teacher while being addressed

### **Disruption**

- Distracting a peer during independent work time
- Leaving seat repeatedly
- Talking while teacher is talking

### **Inappropriate Language**

- Swear words (bleeped out on TV)
- Harassing another student

### **Physical Contact/Physical Aggression**

- Horseplay/Goofing Around\*
- Physical contact without malicious intent\*

\*that could cause injury or a dangerous environment for themselves or others

### **Property Misuse**

- Throwing a binder
- Breaking someone's pencil
- Writing on desk
- Kicking or slamming locker
- Misuse of bathroom facilities and supplies

### **Tardy**

- Student arrives after class has started

### **Technology Violation**

- Playing games, messaging, or taking pictures during class
- Straying from expected app or site (for purposes not related to school or research)

**Unprepared for class (if the 3rd offense in your class in a week (M-F) and there is Not a solution that can be done in the classroom and/or problem solved** (i.e. given or borrow a pencil, use a charger in the room, etc.)

- iPad not charged
- Forgetting materials needed for class
